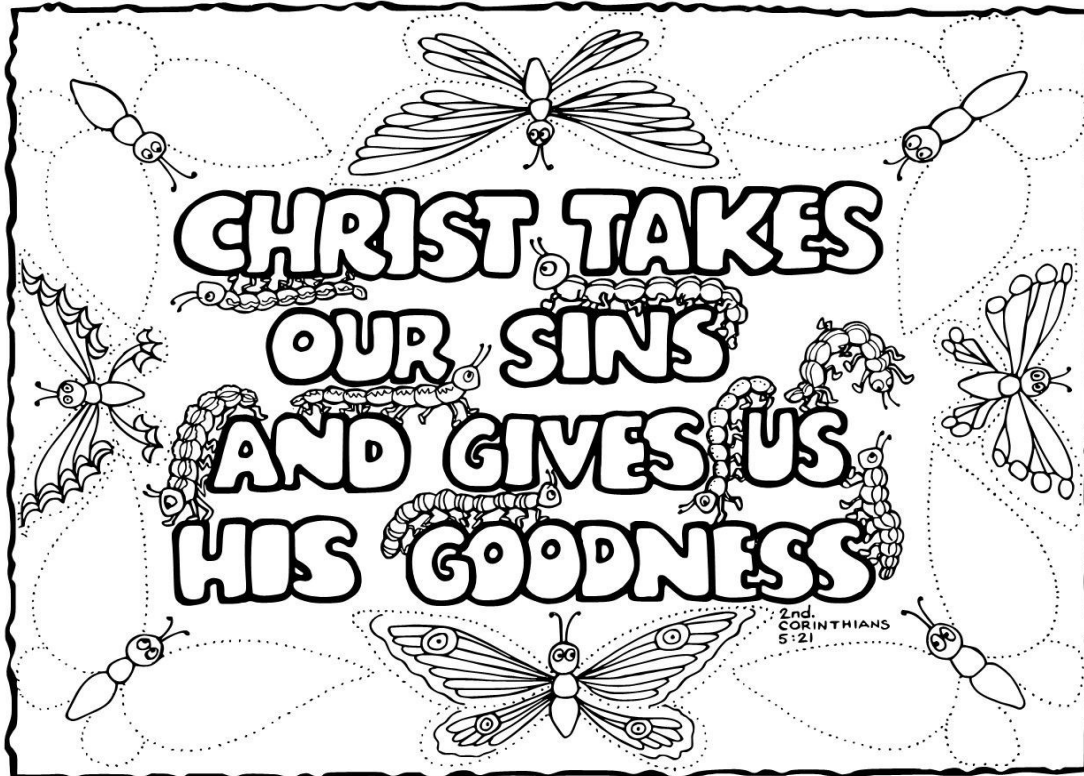

WHAT DID JESUS TAKE FROM HIS PEOPLE? THEIR SIN

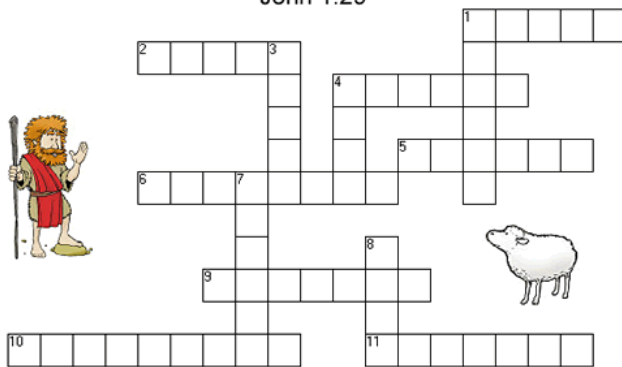


Grubs becoming butterflies makes us think of people becoming Christians - everything becomes new and different.

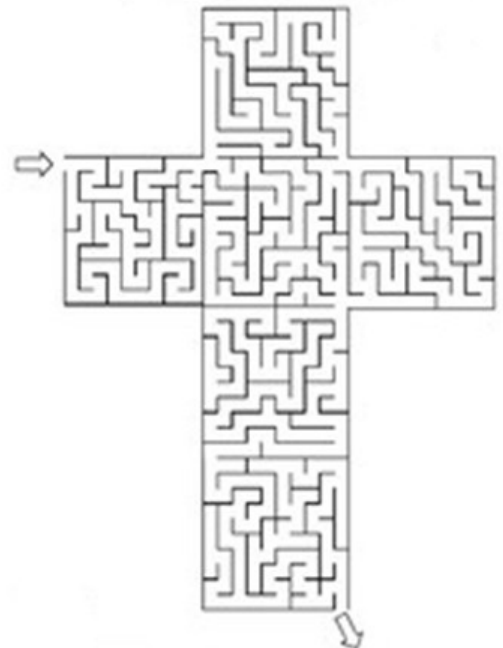
