GOD KNOWS EVERYTHING

The **Bible** is full of verses that tell us how much God knows about **everyone**. For example, in the book of Psalms we learn that God knows the **secrets** of the heart (Psalm 44:21), and God knows the **thoughts** of man. (Psalm 94:11) King David wrote, "He **knows** how we are **formed**, he **remembers** that we are dust." (Psalm 103:14). Matthew recorded the words of Jesus, who said, "Your **father** knows what you **need** before you ask him." (Matthew 6:8) Jesus referred to us as **sheep**. Jesus said, "I am the Good Shepherd, I know my sheep and my sheep know me." (John 10:14) The Apostle Paul wrote, "God, who knows the **heart**." (Acts 15:8). Perhaps the Apostle John said it best when he wrote, "God knows **everything**." (1 John 3:20b).
